

Compliance with the REACH Regulation

The REACH Regulation (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals), which became law on December 18, 2006, governs the use of chemical substances in the European Union (EU) to protect human health and the environment.

This legislation applies to common substances used daily by manufacturers, importers, and professional users of chemicals, as well as importers and manufacturers of articles containing chemicals.

As a downstream user, Decal is responsible for ensuring that its production processes comply with REACH, which includes continuous monitoring of the registration of all substances in its products by its suppliers.

Our compliance with REACH legislation includes informing our customers about products containing substances of very high concern (SVHC), listed on the SVHC Candidate List.

We notify the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) and customers who have purchased or are purchasing specific articles whenever our suppliers declare the presence of these substances in their products at a mass concentration (w/w) equal to or greater than 0.1%.
